Practice Exchange is designed to be a safe and supported context for organisations to review and develop their practice in responding to Domestic and Family Violence and related forms of adversity. Practice Exchange explores these responses at a granular real-world real-work level – on the level of practice. Commencing with a two day masterclass, followed by six 2hr sessions (one per month per participating organisation).
